

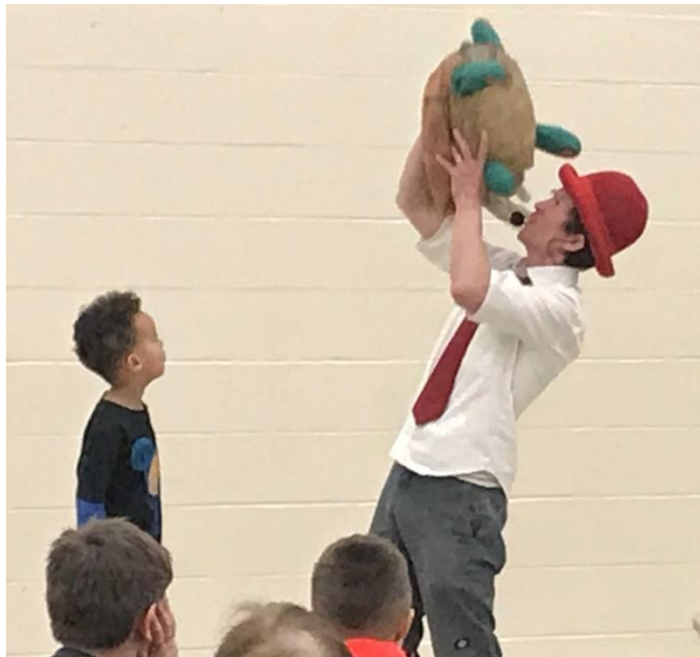
# Thank you from the staff at Wollaston Library
